#### **OPRAH WANTS TO RETURN TO SCHOOL**

Oprah, 16 years old, was among the girls kidnapped from a secondary girls' school in Zamfara state, Nigeria. She says that despite her horrific ordeal, she wants to return to schoolbut not until the security situation improves.

Speaking to the BBC, the girl described her terror the night when gunmen seized 279 of them and took them into the forest. She described how the loud gunshots woke them up at around 1:00 that night. "We thought it was our teachers that had come to wake us up for morning prayers. But there were gunshots as the men came into our hostel - at which point we were screaming", she said. The gunmen threatened to shoot whoever continued screaming and that terrified the girls further. Then, the captors ordered them to leave the school, shooting into the air. After that, they obliged them to go into the forest behind the school.

All the 279 girls that were kidnapped have now been released. Back to her village, Oprah still sees school as her priority. "The experience won't stop my education. I really want to go back to school because I want a bright future - but we need government to deploy permanent security forces to our school before I can have the courage of going back", she said.
