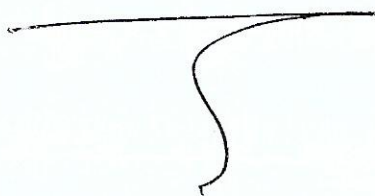

TASK A = Informal letter writing

I/ General expectations

- giving reply to the letter by giving their viewpoints on the issue or just by following the ideas suggested.

II/ Marking criteria

- ① Layout: That of an informal letter →
- ② Relevance: —————→ 6 marks
- ③ Mechanics of writing (paragraphing, punctuation, capitalization ...) —————→ 6 marks
- ④ Cohesion and coherence —————→ 4 marks
- ⑤ Flow of ideas: number and pertinence of reasons as well as examples put forwards to illustrate one's position → 4 marks
- ⑥ Correctness of Language (grammar and vocabulary) —————→ 4 marks
